in your news in brief this hour:

# Police have arrested a 34-year-old teacher for allegedly raping a 14-year old girl. The SAPS said in a statement today that the Limpopo learner was told to clean the staff room earlier this week. A teacher allegedly asked for the girl's cellphone number. Later in the day the suspect called the victim and when she went to meet him took her in his car to a field and raped her.

# The five CPUT students who allegedly torched a university shuttle on October 23 - have been released on bail. The five appeared in the Cape Town Magistrate's Court earlier today. They have been charged with arson, intimidation and public violence.

# The police are investigating the death of a third-year law student from the University of Walter Sisulu ... who has allegedly been beaten by other students. DispatchLive reports that Songezo Takezi, and an unknown, man were severely beaten by other students after being accused of stealing from a residence.
